Special Feature - A Gold Winning Project

CURTIN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS INTERNAL & EXTERNAL SIGNAGE

In 2019 PS Structures commissioned internal and external signage for Curtin University's new Midland Campus. The three-storey facility features state-of-the-art learning spaces with a focus on Health Science disciplines. Our scope of works included:-

- Wayfinding directories – timber veneer panel as backplane measuring 2.2m with aluminium sign panel overlay, edges flush to back plate. Suspended and wall mounted wayfinding signs with arrows. Wayfinding lift directories and numbers made from timber veneer, router cut to reveal concrete backing.
- Reception logo panels saying 'Curtin University' in the main lobby.
- Room ID's – to both glazing or doors featuring room number, room name and Nyungar translation.
- Feature Graphics – six digital wallpaper prints as illustrative feature images to textured wallpaper for artistic impact. Hung in drops on either walls or glazing. General graphics – graphic strips on glazing and privacy bands on offices.

- Welcome Wall Storyboards – 6mm aluminium with print plus router cut lettering into substrate and infill with paint. Featuring the Long Tail Turtle, Bush Tailed Possum and Red Tailed Black Cockatoo. Located on each floor and translated into Nyungar.
- Statutory signage such as Fire Safety Doors, No Unauthorised Access, Office, Meeting Rooms. Facility Door Signs – acrylic fabricated sign panels for Toilets, Parents Room etc. Featuring name, braille and Nyungar translation.
- External Midland Curtin University corporate logo identification signage on the building face are internally lit 3D LED letters mounted on rails painted to match the brickwork.
- Parking totem – finished height 3.8 metres tall made out of aluminium panels with vinyl lettering at entry point.
- Scooter parking signs–Scooter signs out of aluminium sign panels.
- Interpretive signage – external signs featuring medicinal plants for garden areas on plinths.

The key challenges of this project were the diversity of sign types and working with other contractors on site to achieve the stated deadlines.
